**TWO-DAY TRAINING FOR EDUCATORS ON SALUTOGENIC SCHOOL:
DEVELOPING OPEN SPACES FOR GROWTH AND WELL-BEING**

TO: All School Heads of SV-SLR District
School Physical Facilities Coordinators
All Others Concerned

1. In line with the Department of Education's MATATAG Agenda—specifically the pillars of Taking care of learners by promoting inclusive learning environments and Giving support to teachers to teach better, the San Vicente – San Lorenzo Ruiz District will conduct a **Two-Day Training for Educators on Salutogenic School: Developing Open Spaces for Growth and Well-Being (Empowering Leaders, Inspiring Learners)** on May 18-19, 2026 at San Vicente Central School, San Vicente, Camarines Norte.
2. The training aims to empower school leaders and coordinators to:
 - a. Understand and apply the three pillars of salutogenesis: comprehensibility, manageability, and meaningfulness.
 - b. Transform rigid physical and social structures into open spaces that encourage collaboration and emotional safety.
 - c. Integrate wellness strategies directly into school culture and curriculum rather than treating them as extracurricular additions.
3. The participants on this training are the elementary and secondary school heads and school physical facilities coordinators of San Vicente-San Lorenzo Ruiz District.
4. A registration of **Nine Hundred Fifty Pesos** to cover meals shall be charged against the school MOOE while the Implementing Units shall pay their registration to the cashier's office. The transportation of the participants shall also be charged to the school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Meeting of the members of the Technical Working Group will be on May 14, 2026 at San Vicente Central School.
